

# Bedstone College 75 for 75 Club

## The Rules

1. The object of the Club is to raise funds for the College that will be put towards a project in celebration of its 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary in 2023.
2. The Club will be run on behalf of the Old Bedstonian Society by Nigel Vause, 1 Cotton Close, Alrewas, Burton on Trent, Staffs, DE13 7BF. Email address: [b75475@yahoo.co.uk](mailto:b75475@yahoo.co.uk).
3. The Club is open to anyone. Club applicants must fill in the Club application form as supplied on the College website ([www.bedstone.org](http://www.bedstone.org)) or by requesting it from Nigel Vause, (details above). Members MUST ensure that the address held by Nigel Vause is kept up to date.
4. There is no restriction on the number of members. Members must be over 16 years of age.
5. Entry will be by subscription of £5 per number per month. Numbers will be allocated in sequence. Members may have as many numbers as they would like. 20% of the subscription will be set aside for distribution via prize draws, the remaining 80% will be regarded as a donation to the College's 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary fund. Numbers are not transferrable.
6. Subscriptions must be paid either monthly by Standing Order – on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the month, or by cheque, paying a full annualised subscription per number requested (i.e. £60 per number per annum). Upon application being received members will be notified by email (or post in exceptional circumstances) of the number(s) they have been allocated and, where applicable, the Standing Order reference that *must* be used. Failure to use the correct reference, or the correct payment date may lead to the member being excluded from prize draws.
7. New members will not be included in the first draw to take place following their joining but every subsequent draw until the member cancels their Standing Order, or fails to renew their annual payment by cheque. **Please note - it is the responsibility of members to ensure their membership does not lapse.**
8. Until the Club has more than 50 numbers allocated, only 1 annual draw will be held, at an Old Bedstonian Society's committee meeting nearest to the launch date of the club (16<sup>th</sup> November 2013), and annually thereon. The prize will be dependent upon the fund size. It is the intention to issue all surplus funds as prizes. The Society will endeavour to inform members when the minimum has been reached for 3 draws per year (i.e. 50 or more numbers). The 3 draws will be held at Old Bedstonian Society committee meetings (dates vary). It is proposed to draw 3 numbers with prizes allocated in tiers for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. However, the committee reserve the right to change both the prize levels and the number of prizes at any time. Winning members will be notified by email (and in exceptional circumstances by post) and funds will be paid out by cheque. Prize draw results will also be

published on the Old Bedstonian and College websites, in any associated newsletters and on relevant social media groups where applicable.

9. There will be no refund of subscriptions. If a member cancels their Standing Order or fails to renew their annual membership by cheque, they will immediately be excluded from future draws. Those paying by annual subscription will be sent a reminder to renew their subscription 1 month in advance. The administrators reserve the right to refuse the cancelling member re-entry into the Club at a later date.

10. A members' register will be kept centrally recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them. All members will be required to provide an email address in order for the administrators to communicate with them throughout the year. It is the member's responsibility to ensure their contact details are kept up to date with the administrator. Bank details of members, where applicable, will be held by Nigel Vause. The Club administrators agree to comply with the Data Protection Act in handling all personal information.

11. If a winning member cannot be contacted, their winnings will be placed into the College 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary fund.

12. The decision of the Old Bedstonian Society shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication.

13. The Old Bedstonian Society Committee have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 75 for 75 Club members as is deemed necessary.
