Guidelines

For Health and Safety reasons **no jewellery** may be worn for PE/Games/DT lessons/Science lessons and hair must be tied back. Girls can only wear one set of earrings and they are to be gold studs (worn in the lower lobe only). One ring may be worn. No other jewellery is allowed. Students are not permitted to dye their hair in shocking colours. Extremes of fashion are not permitted. Make up, if worn, should be minimal and natural-looking with 'nude' foundation.

Additional items for boarding students

These are suggestions for what to bring and depend on the season. If you have queries, please do contact us. For quantities, bear in mind there is a laundry service every day.

- Casual clothes for evenings and weekends
- Smart clothes suitable for theatre visits
- Pair of Wellington / waterproof / gum boots
- Small weekend case
- 5 pairs of pants/knickers (minimum) and vests (if worn)
- Dressing gown and pairs of pyjamas or nightdresses, pair of bedroom slippers
- Two duvet cover sets and sheets (however not essential – we can supply. You do not need to bring duvets or pillows)
- Large bath towels, face towel
- Toilet bag to include at least: Hairbrush, Comb, Toothpaste, Toothbrush, Shower gel, Roll on / Stick deodorant (**no aerosols**), Face flannels, Nailbrush and Scissors
- Clothes brush
- Shoe cleaning equipment
- Spare name tapes – ideally the iron-on type
- Mug for hot drinks - ideally with a lid
- Laundry mesh bags to keep socks or small items together when in the laundry

Non-uniform items

Large bag to carry school books

Ink pen (gel, fountain or cartridge)

Dictionary

Scientific Calculator

Suitcase and Weekend case

Tuck/tupperware box for snacks

Laptop, games console, books, toys - whatever will help make your child feel at home.

Pencil case containing (transparent cases only allowed into examinations): Pens, Pencils, Rubber, Ruler, etcetera

Mathematical equipment set (pair of compasses, protractor, set square)

Writing paper, envelopes and stamps – if the student intends writing home

Extra-curricular items

These are **only**** needed if the student intends to take one of these as an optional activity. It is advisable to check that the activity is running and there is space for your child before buying any of this equipment.**

- Optional Mountain biking activity – helmet and a bike are essential, protective leg, knee and arm pads are advisable.
- Optional Horse riding activity – gloves and a waterproof coat are essential, hat and boots are available at the riding school.
- Optional Dance activity – appropriate dance wear eg leotard/unitard, leggings, jazz or ballet shoes.
