Ear-rings: No boy may wear an ear-ring. Rings: One plain signet ring is allowed. For Health and Safety reasons no jewellery may be worn for PE/Games/DT lessons/Science lessons.

Additional items for boarding students:

Casual clothes for evenings and weekends

Smart clothes suitable for theatre visits

Pair of Wellington (waterproof / gum) boots

Small weekend case

5 pairs of boxer shorts or pants (minimum)

Vests (if worn)

Dressing gown, Pairs of pyjamas and pair of bedroom slippers (last not obligatory)

Two duvet cover sets, pillowcases and single bed sheets (duvet and pillows are not essential but you may bring your own)

Large bath towels and face towels

Toilet bag to include at least: Hairbrush, Comb, Toothpaste, Toothbrush, Shower gel, Roll on /

Stick deodorant (no aerosols), Face flannels, Nail brush and Scissors

Clothes brush and shoe cleaning equipment

Spare name tapes, preferably the iron-on type

Mug for hot drinks preferably with lid

Laundry mesh bags to keep small items such as socks

Non-uniform items:

Large bag to carry school books Ink pen (gel, fountain or cartridge)

Good scientific calculator Dictionary

Laptop, games consoles, books (optional) Tuck box for snacks

Pencil case containing (transparent cases only allowed into examinations):

Pens, Pencils, Rubber, Ruler, Mathematical equipment set (pair of compasses, protractor, set square) ... etc.

Writing paper, envelopes and stamps if the boarder intends to write home.

Extra-curricular items:

Students taking music as an option need black smart clothes for performing in concerts.

These are **only** needed if the student intends to take these as an optional activity. Please check that the activity is running & there is space for your child before buying this equipment.

- Optional Mountain biking activity helmet and a bike are essential, protective leg, knee and arm pads are advisable.
- Optional Horse riding activity gloves and a waterproof coat are essential, hat and boots are available at the riding school.
- Optional Dance activity appropriate dancewear eg unitard, leggings, jazz/ballet shoes.
