



Sixth Form Boarding Boys' Uniform

Our uniform shop is available on campus and to order online at schoolshopdirect.co.uk. We recommend ordering online if possible.

To make a fitting appointment, which is highly recommended as ordered sizes may vary, please email uniform.shop@bedstone.org or call +44 (0)1547 530303. If ordered uniform does not fit, it can be exchanged.

Uniform can be paid for in cash, by credit card online or by BACs but cannot be added to the fees bill. Please ensure students arriving unaccompanied have sufficient funds available to pay for the uniform in full or it has been paid online in advance.

Sixth Form Day Uniform:

Sixth Formers dress in business attire throughout the school day. This consists of:

- Lounge suit, plain/pin-striped shirt, school tie, socks hooped/coloured/plain.
- plain navy blue or black V-neck sweater may be worn under jackets in winter months.
- In the summer term a jacket/blazer and different coloured trousers may be worn.
- Jackets, blazers, trousers must be plain and the colour must be within business norms.
- A waistcoat is permissible provided that it is of a plain design.
- Top button must be fastened.
- Ties must be done up to the top button and end at the top of the trousers (belt line).
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Shirts should be in colours appropriate for business.
- Black shoes: must be 'flat', sturdy and polishable.

Guidelines:

Hair: Must be short enough that it doesn't need to be tied back. Hair cannot be shorter than a hairdresser's 'number 2'. Hair should not be over the face/eyes or be below the collar. No dyeing of hair allowed. A small amount of hair gel is allowed provided that the resulting hair style conforms to acceptable norms.

Ear-rings: No boy may wear an ear-ring.

Rings: One plain signet ring is allowed.

For Health and Safety reasons **no jewellery** may be worn for PE/Games/DT /Science lessons.

Scarves: In cold weather, navy blue scarves are permitted. These must be plain and not 'fringed'. They should not be worn indoors.

Non-uniform items:

Large bag to carry school books

Ink pen (gel, fountain or cartridge)

Dictionary

Tuck or Tupperware box

Writing paper, envelopes, stamps (if they want to write home)

Pencil case containing (*transparent cases only allowed into examinations*):

Pens, Pencils, Rubber, Ruler, Mathematical equipment (good scientific calculator, pair of compasses, protractor, set square) ... etc.

Additional items for boarding students:

** please ensure ALL items of clothing are labelled with the student's name**

- Casual clothes for evenings and weekends
- Smart clothes suitable for theatre visits
- Pair of Wellington boots (gum / waterproof boots)
- Suitcase and small weekend case
- 5 pairs of boxer shorts or pants (minimum) and Vests (if worn)
- Dressing gown, Pairs of pyjamas, Pair of bedroom slippers (not essential)
- Two duvet cover sets, pillowcases and sheets (duvet is not essential)
- Large bath towels and face towel
- Toilet bag including: Hairbrush, Comb, Toothpaste, Toothbrush, Shower gel, Roll on / Stick deodorant (**no** aerosols), Face flannels, Nail brush and Scissors
- Clothes brush and shoe cleaning equipment
- Spare name tapes – ideally the iron-on type
- Mug for hot drinks – ideally with a lid
- Laundry mesh bags to keep socks or small items together.

Extra-curricular items:

Students taking music as an option need black smart clothes for performing in concerts.

These are *only**** needed if the student intends to take these as an optional activity. Please check that the activity is running & there is space for your child before buying this equipment.***

- Optional Mountain biking activity – helmet and a bike are essential, protective leg, knee and arm pads are advisable.
- Optional Horse riding activity – gloves and a waterproof coat are essential, hat and boots are available at the riding school.

Optional Dance activity – appropriate dancewear eg unitard, leggings, jazz/ballet shoes.
