If ordered uniform does not fit, it can be exchanged.

Uniform can be paid for in cash, by credit card online or by BACs but <u>cannot</u> be added to the fees bill. Please ensure students arriving unaccompanied have sufficient funds available to pay for the uniform in full or it has been paid online in advance.

Guidelines

For Health and Safety reasons **no jewellery** may be worn for PE/Games/DT lessons/Science lessons and hair must be tied back. Students taking music as an option need black smart clothes for performing in concerts.

These are ******only****** needed if the student intends to take these as an optional activity. Please check that the activity is running & there is space for your child <u>before</u> buying this equipment.

- Optional Mountain biking activity helmet and a bike are essential, protective leg, knee and arm pads are advisable.
- Optional Horse riding activity gloves and a waterproof coat are essential, hat and boots are available at the riding school.
- Optional Dance activity appropriate dancewear eg unitard, leggings, jazz/ballet shoes.
