A Registration fee of £100 is required with the completed registration form.

- > A Deposit of £500 for UK and EU applications is required to secure a place.
- An applicant with a non EU passport is required to pay a deposit of £2000.00. If the student is unsuccessful in being granted a visa this will be refunded (minus the College's expenses).
- Bedstone College operates an "all inclusive" fee policy where <u>no additional charges</u> are made for books, stationery, school daily transport (if using a school minibus), public examinations sat for the first time, linen, laundry and food.
- > The only additions to fees paid are Learning Support and EAL (if required) plus pocket money and any extra curricular activities (such as horse riding and music lessons).
- > The fees are reviewed annually by the Governing Body of the College in March. The fees for the following academic year are published on the school website in April and current parents receive notification in the Headmaster's end of term letter.
- Payment of fees by monthly installments is available with "School Fee Plan" please contact the Accounts Administrator if you require further details.
- Bedstone offers a variety of scholarships and bursaries. Bursaries are means tested and application forms are available from the Bursary.
- > All scholarships are awarded on merit, gauged by overall performance on Scholarship day, which is usually held in early Spring.
