

International Student (Non-EU) 'All inclusive' Fee Structure 2018 - 19

Bedstone College aims to smooth the admissions process for international students and their parents. We have introduced a special 'allinclusive fee' for students who need intensive support with their English or those students who are unsure which A Levels they would like to take.

All Tier 4 students on this fee will be entitled to the services of the International Welfare Officer, (IWO). This member of staff is specifically responsible for overseeing the care of international students. Parents of international students can feel remote and isolated especially until their child has settled. The IWO is available



throughout term time and will respond to parents/guardians/agents within 48 hours of receipt of any communication.

Throughout the year the IWO acts as a liaison point between parents, guardians, agents, tutors and houseparents and students. They will meet with the student at least once each week and meet with parents, if required, when they visit during term time
