## A Registration fee of £100 is required with the completed registration form.

- ➤ A Deposit of £2000 for applications is required to secure a place.
- Bedstone College operates an "all inclusive" fee policy where no additional charges are made for books, stationery, school daily transport (if using a school minibus), public examinations sat for the first time, linen, laundry and food.
- The only additions to fees paid are Learning Support and EAL\* (if required) plus pocket money and any extra curricular activities (such as horse riding and music lessons).
- > Bedstone offers a variety of scholarships for international students in both the junior and senior sections of the school.
- > All scholarships are awarded on merit, gauged by overall performance. International scholarship assessments are usually conducted when a representative of the college visits the host country, but can also be arranged via a separate online assessment procedure.
