The items on this list can be bought from any retailer. Sixth Formers are expected to wear smart, business attire throughout the school day.

Smart Trouser Suits and / or Smart Skirt Suits Business-like skirts below knee to mid-calf Pastel-shade or white blouses (nothing neon or garish) Jumpers-plain and in muted shades Shower proof navy jacket or a navy Crombie-style overcoat Polishable black shoes 2½-5cm heel max	Lounge suit, plain/pin-striped shirt, school tie, socks hooped/coloured/plain. Plain navy blue or black V-neck sweater may be worn under jackets in winter months. A waistcoat is permissible provided that it is of a plain design. In the summer term a jacket/blazer and different coloured trousers may be worn. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Shirts should be in colours appropriate for business. Top button must be fastened. Jackets, blazers, trousers must be plain and the colour must be within business norms. *Bedstone tie (<i>Ties must be done up to the top button and end at the top of the trousers - belt line</i>). Strong, sensible, dark polishable school shoes

<p>Hair: Girls are not permitted to dye their hair in shocking colours. Long hair must be tied back. Extremes of fashion are not permitted.</p> <p>Jewellery: Girls can only wear one set of earrings and they are to be gold studs (worn in the lower lobe only). Necklace – religious symbols only. No other jewellery is allowed.</p> <p>Make up: if worn, should be minimal and natural-looking with 'nude' foundation.</p>	<p>Hair: Must be short enough that it doesn't need to be tied back. Hair cannot be shorter than a hairdresser's 'number 2'. Boys are not permitted to dye their hair in shocking colours. Hair should not be over the face/eyes or be below the collar. Extremes of fashion are not permitted.</p> <p>A small amount of hair gel is allowed provided that the resulting hair style conforms to acceptable norms.</p> <p>Earrings: No boy may wear an earring. Rings – One plain signet ring is allowed</p>
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No jewellery may be worn for PE/Games/DT lessons/Science lessons
